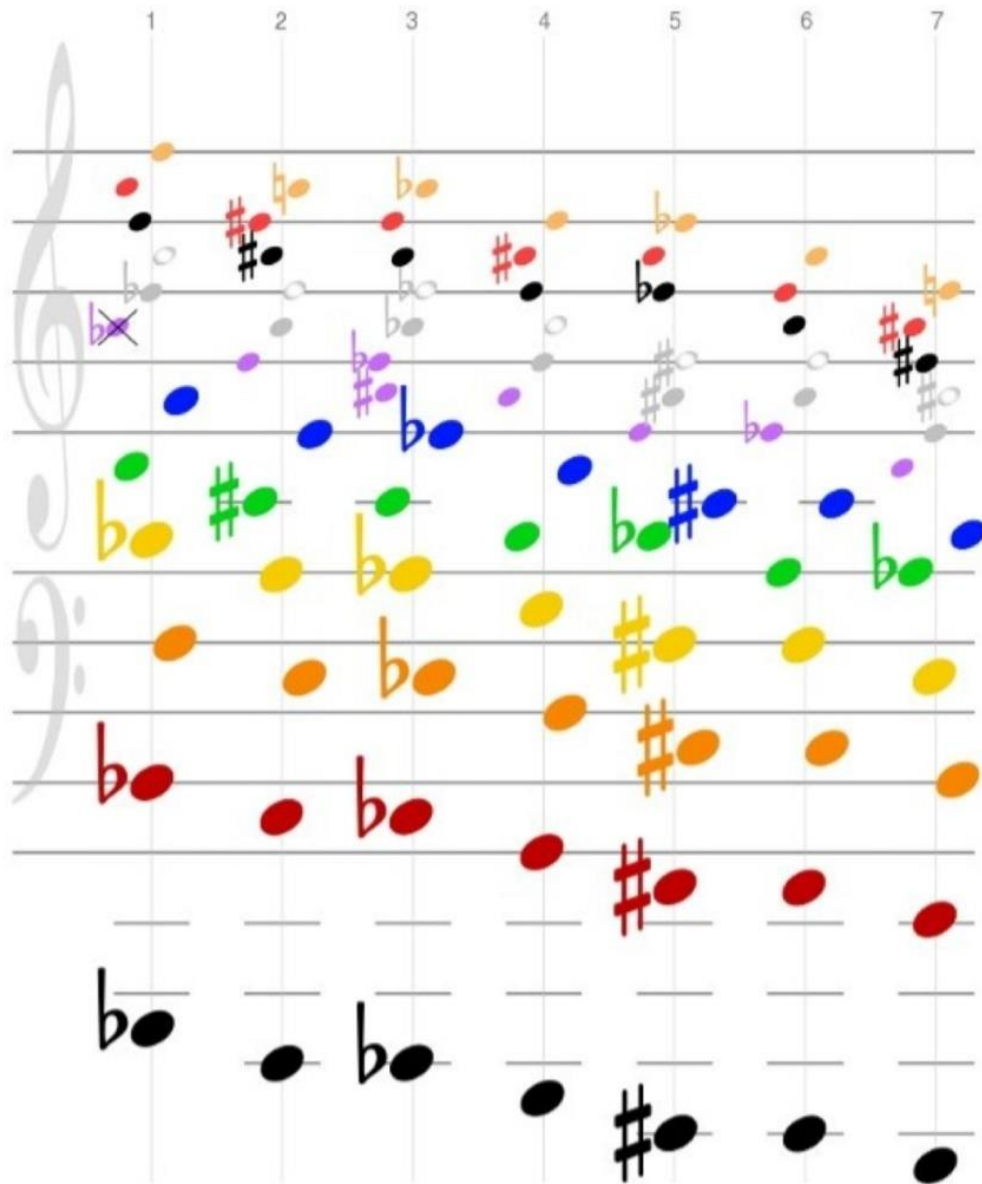


Trombone Slide Chart

w/ Tendencies



DETAILS

- Each color represents the partials of the instrument.
- The note head moved to the left indicates the note is typically flat, to the right indicates the note is typically sharp. Alter the position with the slide. Example: 7th partial G is played in a sharp 2nd position.
- 7th partial Ab (purple) cannot be played in 1st position. It is flat and cannot be raised further in 1st position, similar to 5th partial D.
- An experienced player can manipulate notes with their embouchure. Lip-down or up to achieve in tune pitches.
